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**ORDER:-**

The Management of Solid waste generated by Households, commercial Centers, Institutions, Industries etc., has become a complex problem with the increase in urbanization, growth of population and associated activities. The Municipal Solid Waste Management has assumed the dimension of a major organizational, financial, logistical and environmental challenge over the past few years.

2. The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India admitted the Writ Petition (Civil) No.888 of 1996 and constituted "Asim Barman Committee" to look in to all aspects of Solid Waste Management in India. The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in its order dated 15-02-2000 directed to comply with the suggestions and directions contained in the report prepared by the "Asim Barman Committee and accordingly Government of India issued Municipal Solid Wastes (Management & Handling) Rules 2000, to regulate the Management and Handling of the Municipal Solid Wastes.

3. Government have constituted Technical Committee and State Level Official Committee vide G.O first read above and State Level Technical Committee vide G.O. second read above for effective implementation of Municipal Solid Wastes (Management & Handling) Rules 2000 and relevant provisions of Water Act,1974 and the Environment Protection Act, 1986 relating to Municipal Sewage Management.

4. Government have issued comprehensive guidelines / strategy for setting up of Municipal solid waste processing plants and power projects with Municipal Solid Waste in all Nagar Panchayats / Municipalities / Municipal Corporations in the State. The Government have also approved the establishment of 19 clusters for integrated

management of the Municipal Solid Waste on cluster based approach to take up Integrated Municipal Solid Waste management.

5. The Nagar Panchyats / Municipalities and Municipal Corporations in the State have not implemented the said Rules effectively and completely due to the inadequacy in data and reliability of data, identification and implementation of the right and cost-effective technology besides availability of land, finances, power purchase agreements. Some issues are not directly in the hands of the implementing agencies. In order to overcome the above situation and to ensure compliance with the Municipal Solid Waste Management Rules and the constant directions being issued by the Apex Court, it is felt necessary to constitute a separate high level board to handle the inter-departmental issues, investment related issues, to handle the grossly neglected subject effectively to protect Public Health, Safety and Environment in the State and to take the integrated management of the Municipal Solid Waste in to a **Mission Mode** with a vision to make a sustainable Andhra Pradesh where unique natural environment is preserved for future generation.

6 After careful examination of the matter, Government hereby constitute “**Andhra Pradesh Integrated Solid Waste Management Board**” with the following dignitaries for effective implementation of Municipal Solid Wastes (Management & Handling) Rules 2000 and related issues in the State :

7 The Andhra Pradesh Integrated Solid Waste Management Board will co-opt any expert as a member of the Board from time to time as per the necessity.

8 The Board is established for achieving the following **goals** in management of Municipal Solid Waste Management

- i. Increase Inter departmental participation in resource conservation, integrated waste management, waste prevention, and product stewardship to reduce waste and create a sustainable infrastructure.
- ii. Manage and mitigate the impacts of solid waste on public health safety of handlers and the environment. Streamline the permissions and inspection procedures and promote integrated and consistent enforcement efforts.
- iii. Improve the efficiency and effectiveness of personnel and processes involved in integrated solid waste management.
- iv. Increase the level of environmental education and technical assistance to all stakeholders about resource conservation and integrated waste management strategies.
- v. Promote a “ Zero-waste Andhra Pradesh” where the public, industry and government strive to reduce, reuse, or recycle all municipal solid waste materials back into nature or the marketplace in a manner that protects human health and the environment.

9. The Board is mandated to act with following responsibilities :

- i) Develop and approve overall policy frame work
- ii) Provide interdepartmental co-ordination in preparation of long term strategic plan and short term annual work plan on integrated solid waste management.
- iii) Oversee implementation aspects and give necessary directions
- iv) Single Window clearance of projects.
- v) Explore investment related options.
- vi) Other aspects if any to achieve above goals.

10. The Andhra Pradesh Integrated Solid Waste Management Board shall meet once in three months or earlier as may be necessary and the board should have a seed capital of Rs. 15.00 Crores.
