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The A.P. Pollution Control Board, Head office, Hyderabad vide reference 1<sup>st</sup> cited issued work order to Dept of Civil Engineering, SVU College of Engineering, Tirupati for third party inspections for Environmental compliance of certain medium risk category industries located in SPSR Nellore, Chittoor, YSR Kadapa, Anantapur & Kurnool districts This initiative was taken up as per the recommendations DIPP under “Ease of Doing Business” initiatives of the Central Government. The Categories of Dairy and Dairy products, Vegetable Oil Manufacturing including refinery, Food & Food processing industries including fruits and vegetable processing, Sea Food processing units & Coffee Seed processing industries are included in the third party inspections.

It was reported by the Dept of Civil Engineering, SVU College of Engineering, Tirupati that they have inspected only 23 industries as per the above work order within the time frame out of which the inspection reports of 13 industries were submitted to the Board and yet to submit the remaining 10 reports.

The Head of Dept. vide Ir dt. 01.07.2017 requested to extend the validity of work order by one more year to facilitate visit of all the industries.

The Member Secretary, APPCB, vide reference 3<sup>rd</sup> cited instructed the Joint Chief Environmental Engineer, Zonal office, Kurnool to discuss with the representative university department and extend the work order on the earlier terms and conditions for one more year. The officials of APPCB contacted the Head of Dept., Civil Engineering, SVU College of Engineering, Tirupati and informed that the Dept. of Civil Engineering was willing to carryout the inspections on the terms and conditions of earlier work order dt.23.05.2016.

Hence, it is decided to extend the work order for one more year to the Dept of Civil Engineering, SVU College of Engineering, Tirupati for third party inspections for Environmental compliance of medium risk category industries located in Chittoor, YSR Kadapa, Anantapur & Kurnool districts as per the list enclosed. (Annexure – I & II). The details of consent orders, directions issued, operating status and location details of the above industries will be supplied by concerned Regional Officers of the Board.

**The work order is valid for one year i.e., upto 30.09.2018 with following terms and conditions:**

1. The third party i.e., Department of Civil Engineering, SVU College of Engineering, Tirupati shall conduct Environmental Compliance inspection on behalf of A.P.Pollution Control Board as provisioned under the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and amendments thereof.
2. The industries are to be inspected by the qualified personnel of the third party i.e., Department of Civil Engineering, SVU College of Engineering, Tirupati to verify the

compliance status with respect to standards/conditions stipulated by the Board in the consent orders issued under the Water Act, 1974 and the Air Act, 1981 and their amendments and Hazardous Waste authorizations issued under HWM rules of the Environment Protection Act, 1986.


3. A detailed report of inspection in the enclosed format is to be submitted within 15 days from the date of inspection positively.
4. The third party shall collect samples of effluent at inlet and outlet of ETP and stack emission as required for verification of compliance as per the standards/conditions stipulated in the consent orders.
5. All the operating industries in the listed industries (Annexure – I & II) shall be inspected during one year period i.e., before 30.09.2018.
6. The industries listed at annexure – I shall be inspected first. Only after completion of the inspections of the industries listed in annexure – I, the industries listed at annexure – II shall be inspected. The industries listed at annexure – I & II shall not be inspected more than once.
7. The Board shall pay the charges to the third party for Environmental compliance inspection as follows:

Condition	Charges to be paid by Board (Excluding Service Tax as applicable)
On submission of report in the attached format which includes conveyance charges, inspection/field visit charges, report preparation and submission charges	Rs.20,000/-
Collection & analysis of effluent samples for parameters pH, TSS, TDS, BOD chlorides, sulphates and COD (each sample)	Rs.2,500/-
Collection & analysis of stack emissions (Particulate matter) per stack	Rs.2,500/-

8. The third party shall submit Environmental Compliance inspection report in the attached format by mail to [zoknl-jcee@appcb.gov.in](mailto:zoknl-jcee@appcb.gov.in) under copy to [zoknl-ee2@appcb.gov.in](mailto:zoknl-ee2@appcb.gov.in) scanned copies of inspection report shall be submitted through the mail along with scanned copies of analysis reports and other enclosures.
9. The Board shall have right to cancel the work order with one month notice.
