

Minutes of the Environmental Public Hearing in connection with the M/s. Janany Cement Industries Private Limited has proposed to set up a standalone Cement Grinding unit of 300 TPD in Survey No. 462, Industrial Park, Guntakindapalli Village, Srikalahasthi Mandal, Chittoor District on 24.08.2017 at 10.00 a.m.

In accordance with the Notification No. S.O. 1533 dt. 14.09.2006 of Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, New Delhi, the Environmental Engineer, Andhra Pradesh Pollution Control Board, Regional Office, Tirupati issued a notification pertaining to the Environmental Public Hearing on the M/s. Janany Cement Industries Private Limited has proposed to set up a standalone Cement Grinding unit of 300 TPD in Survey No. 462, Industrial Park, Guntakindapalli Village, Srikalahasthi Mandal, Chittoor District in leading newspapers published on 23.07.2017 inviting suggestions, views, comments and objections of the general public and was conducted on 24.08.2017 at 10.00 a.m at Mandal Parishath Primary School, Guttakindapalli as per the instructions of the District Revenue Officer and Additional District Magistrate and the minutes of the meeting are as follows:

The following Officials attended the Environmental Public Hearing :

The Environmental Engineer, A.P. Pollution Control Board, Tirupati welcomed the District Revenue Officer and Additional District Magistrate, Chittoor District & Chairman of the Public Hearing panel and Public gathered at the Public Hearing venue. He explained the need to conduct Public Hearing for the proposed project as per the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Govt. of India, New Delhi notification 2006.

He also explained as per the Terms of Reference (TOR), SEIAA/AP/CTR/IND/11/2016-238, Dated 31.12.2016 it is necessary to get the public hearing conducted for this project for obtaining the Environment Clearance in accordance with the procedure prescribed under the EIA Notification 2006. Then he requested the District Revenue Officer and Additional District Magistrate, Chittoor District to take over the proceedings of the Environmental Public Hearing.

Then District Revenue Officer and Additional District Magistrate, Chittoor District & Chairman of the Environmental Public Consultation while speaking on the occasion, she informed the importance of the industrialization. She also explained the details of development activities took place viz., health, education and basic amenities at surrounding villages once the industry comes in to operation under Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) funds.

Sri. Srinivasa Reddy, Environmental Consultant of the project, M/s Team Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad while explaining the salient features and technicalities of the proposed project M/s. Janany Cement Industries Pvt. Limited, is proposed to establish a cement clinker grinding unit at an area of 2.93 Ha with an project cost of Rs 5.0 Crores.

He briefly explained the project process that a ball mill will be used for grinding of clinker and other additives then screening and packing. With regard to water pollution industry proposed to use water of 5 KLD only for water sprinkling, greenbelt development and domestic purposes. There won't be any wastewater generation from the process. With regard to Air pollution industry proposed to provide bag filter to the ball mill to minimize the Air pollution on surroundings.

He also explained that they have collected base line data from 10 km radius in between October, 2016 to February, 2017 around the project site to assess the impacts arises from the proposed industry. The observed pollutants were within the limits as per National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS). During the study they have collected water samples and found that the water quality is within the standards stipulated.

Due to establishment of the factory the Socio-economic development of the surrounding villages will occur and industry proposed to provide employment for 23 Nos preferably for locals.

Then the Environmental Engineer & Convener of the Environmental Public Consultation requested the general public to express their opinions/ suggestions, objections, if any, on the proposed project, so as to record the same and will send to the State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA), Andhra Pradesh for taking necessary action.

Sri Janardhan Reddy, NGO, Hyderabad while speaking on the occasion welcomed the proposed project and informed that the proposed unit is only a cement clinker grinding unit and may not pose any environmental threat on surroundings.

Sri. Sunanda Reddy, NGO, while speaking on the occasion welcomed the industrial establishment and made the following suggestions to the management.

1. Majority of the employment shall provide to the local public.
2. Skilled development program shall be conducted at surrounding villages for getting suitable jobs by the local youth.
3. Industry shall construct rain water harvesting structures.
4. CSR budget shall be spent on surrounding villages for providing education and health facilities.

Sri PLN Rao, Environmental Activist: While speaking on the occasion informed that Government have developed so many SEZs in the state but, the industries are not being grounded as expected and also explained there is a need to encourage the enthusiastic industrialists. He further informed that industry shall develop greenbelt on top priority. Bag filters shall be provided to minimize Air pollution on surrounding and also good number of job opportunities shall be provided to the local people.

Sri. N. Ravi Kumar, NGO, while speaking on the occasion informed that any organization or Government's is motto should be to help / serve the people. He appreciated the Chairman of the Public Hearing for conducting the Environmental Public Hearing in the concern village ie, Guttakindapalli. He requested the District Administration to resolve the land acquisition issues and proper compensation shall be made to the local farmers.

Sri. Y. Chennakesava Reddy, while speaking on the occasion, requested the management to develop good greenbelt, construction of rain water harvesting pits and to spent CSR budget at project affected villages.

Sri. P.Nagaraju, r/o Gutakindapalli, expressed his dissatisfaction on delayed and improper information on conducting of Environmental Public Hearing.

Sri. G. Sreeramulu Reddy, r/o Guttakindapalli, while speaking on the occasion have also expressed his dissatisfaction on improper information on conducting of Environmental Public Hearing.

Sri. T. Ravindranath Reddy, Single Window President, Srikalahsthi while speaking on the occasion requested the District management to resolve the land compensation issues to the local farmers, as it is a long pending issue. He also opined that as per the technical presentation and profile of the proposed


industry, there may not be much impact on Environment due to the proposed industry.


Sri. Srinivasa Reddy, Environmental Consultant of the project, M/s Team Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad answered the following on the concerns raised by the public during public hearing on behalf of the management on the industry.

1. Employment will be provided to the local people on priority basis.
2. Bag filters will be provided to minimize the Air pollution problems on surroundings.
3. CSR funds will be spent as per the choice of the surrounding villages (need based).

Then **District Revenue Officer and Additional District Magistrate, Chittoor District** while making conclusive remarks informed that, the issues raised during the Public hearing by the public are mainly on the compensation to the land losers. Even though the said lands are Jamedar Patta's, the issue will be examined positively and proper justice will be made to the farmers.

On seeing no more suggestions / objections from the public **District Revenue Officer and Additional District Magistrate, Chittoor District and the Chairman, Environmental Public Hearing Panel** was concluded the Environmental Public Hearing. With the permission of the Chairman of the Public hearing panel the Environmental Public Hearing was ended with vote of thanks by Assistant Environmental Engineer, AP Pollution Control Board, Tirupati.
